

Character Trading Cards

Show students examples of baseball cards. With this activity, challenge students to create a “trading card” for one of the Who Was...? characters. Cards should include: on one side, a picture of the character, and on the other, a brief bio and key facts that are meaningful to the student about the character.

Challenge students to do more than just the main character of the book by encouraging them to do as many characters from the story as they can. (ex. In the Who Was Daniel? book, students could also make trading cards for Nebuchadnezzar, King Darius, etc.)

A great extension, would be to have students create cards that also represented PLACES and EVENTS found in the story (places could include locations like Babylon, while events could include the lions’ den).
